2017-2018 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION

Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida recognizes that studying in Miami Florida can be a large financial commitment for many students and their families, and we are proud to award scholarships to those who qualify based on economic need.

Please Note: To be considered for a scholarship, all students must have first completed the Registration form and auditioned for the program.

Deadline Information

All scholarship are considered on a first based first served basis and are due early August 1st 2017. We cannot guarantee that any application received after this date will be considered.

Applicants will be notified no later than 2 weeks following the application as to whether or not they have received an award, and if they have, the amount awarded.

Scholarships are limited and priority is given to applications based on the date of receipt.

Scholarship Specifications

Scholarships are awarded depending on financial need and availability of funds.

In order to provide opportunities for as many young artist as possible, scholarships are valid only for the academic school year that begins August 14, 2017 and ends June 9, 2018.

Scholarship funds will be used only for tuition for the School year. Scholarships funds may not be used for any other program, registration fees, meals, dance attire or shoes, traveling or transportation expenses, housing, merchandise or tickets to the performance. Scholarships are strictly non-transferable.

To be considered for a scholarship, please submit the following items:

1. This complete Scholarship Application
2. A letter written by the student explaining why he/she would like to attend Vladimir Issaev School of Classical Ballet
3. A letter written by a parent/guardian stating their desire to have the student attend and detailing the need for financial aid.
4. A letter of recommendation from the student's teacher, director, or private instructor (a written recommendation is not necessary for VISCB alumni who has been attending our programs for more than one year).
5. A check or money order in the amount of \$40.00 made payable to ADA. This NON REFUNDABLE deposit demonstrates that the applicant is serious about attending our 2017-2018 program.
6. A copy of your most recent Federal Tax Return (page 1 ONLY).

Cancellation Policy / Refund of Deposit:

Any recipient of scholarship funds who cannot attend the program for which they are registered must notify VISCB in writing by at least one month (30 days) prior to the start of the program in order to receive a refund of any tuition payment made to VISCB. IF a student cancels enrollment or fails to attend the program within seven (7) days of the start of the program, VISCB cannot issue a credit for any portion of the tuition.

Parents/caregiver understands that he/she will be assigned a certain number of volunteer hours to complete equivalent to the value of the scholarship. Should the parent/caregiver not comply with the amount volunteer hours assigned, the value of the scholarship must be paid in full to VISCB.
